Toggle/Connect (Prerequisite: a call is on consultation hold)	* 2	Enter the DTMF code to switch to the next waiting party.
Conferencing (Prerequisite: a call is on consultation hold)	* 3	Enter the DTMF code to connect multiple parties to a call.
Disconnect and return to held call (Prerequisite: a call is on consultation hold)	* 0	Enter the DTMF code to end the consultation call. You are reconnected to the waiting party.
Activate callback (delete in idle state using [1] [0])	* 5 8	Enter the DTMF code to activate a callback ("Callback on busy" or "Callback on No Answer).
